## GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

### ENHANCING CLIMATE RESILIENCE ON WATER RESOURCES IN MKONDOA CATCHMENT PROJECT (ECRWRMCP).

1. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania, through the Wami/Ruvu Basin Water Board (WRBWB), has secured a grant from the African Development Bank (AfDB) under the Climate Action Window to finance the Enhancing Climate Resilience of Water in the Mkondoa Catchment Project.
2. The primary objective of the Mkondoa Project is to enhance the resilience of the Mkondoa Catchment to climate change by improving water security, restoring degraded ecosystems, and promoting climate-smart land and water management practices. The project seeks to reduce vulnerability to climate variability, safeguard water resources, and strengthen community capacity for sustainable catchment management. The project includes the following procurement methods: Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) and Open Competitive Bidding (OCB).
3. The project includes the following components:
  - Component 1: Strengthening of Institutions and Hydro-meteorological Monitoring Stations
  - Component 2: Climate-Resilient Infrastructure and Ecosystem Restoration
  - Component 3: Project Management
4. Procurement of works, goods, and acquisition of consultancy services financed by the African Development Bank will be carried out in accordance with the “*Procurement Policy and Methodology for Bank Group funded operations*” (BPM), dated October 2015. Bidding and Request for Proposal (RFP) documents are expected to be available in (March/April 2026).
